

Doug's message yesterday had me thinking on God's Love and how he has promised us that love forever. This is one of the most comforting themes woven throughout Scripture with the idea that God's love is not temporary or fragile—it is eternal. In a world where so much shifts beneath our feet, God's promise of forever stands like an anchor, steady and unchanging.

From the earliest pages of the Bible, God reveals Himself as a covenant maker. His promises aren't casual or conditional; they are rooted in His character. When He says, "I will never leave you nor forsake you," He is declaring something far deeper than momentary reassurance. He is offering permanence, presence, and peace that outlasts every season of life.

The promise of forever is not just about eternity after death—it's about God's ongoing faithfulness right now. It means His mercy doesn't run out when we stumble. His grace doesn't expire when we feel unworthy. His love doesn't fade with time or circumstance. Forever means that God's commitment to us is stronger than our doubts, our failures, and even our fears.

For me, this promise becomes a source of courage. When life feels uncertain, God's forever reminds me that we are held by Someone who is not shaken. When I feel alone, His forever assures me that we are never abandoned. And when I wonder whether my story has an ending, His forever tells me that He is still writing it.

In the end, God's promise of forever is not just a theological idea—it's an invitation to rest. To trust. To breathe. To know that the One who created the universe has chosen to love me without end.

And that is a promise worth holding onto.
Forever and ever....Amen.


